

Children's Care Learning and Development (CCLD) NVQ Level 4

Description	The NVQ CCLD Level 4 award is suitable for those in a management or supervisory position in roles such as pre-school adviser, centre manager, area SENCO, senior practitioner involving high-level skills with children and families.
Qualification	The NVQ is a skills benchmark. Achieving Level 4 is an assurance to current and future employers that your skills are up-to-date and at the necessary level. Gaining the award can lead to career advancement, wage increase with recognition and official accreditation of skills and a chance to meet and network with inspectors or development workers. The qualification is structured to allow the candidate to work at their own pace, with their own assessor during working hours.
Timescale	3 to 6 months, dependant on the individual candidates circumstances.

Assessment	<p>Candidates must complete four core units plus five optional units.</p> <p>Assessment is through direct observation within a childcare setting combined with inspection of supplementary evidence such as assignments, professional discussion, witness testimonies and work products.</p>
