

Legal Advice NVQ Level 3

Description	This qualification is aimed at first line advisers. These are defined as people who will explore the client's problem in some detail, provide appropriate advice within their level of responsibility and may prepare cases for court or tribunal, but would be unlikely to present cases. They may also need to refer the client to someone else for more specialist advice.
Qualification	The qualification covers topics such as supporting clients, negotiating on their behalf, and enabling clients to act on their own behalf. It also provides an opportunity for candidates to evaluate and develop their own practice.
Timescale	3 to 9 months, depending on the individual candidates circumstances.
