

Young People of Camden Showcase their Artistic Talent

Young Parlour, an exciting new arts education programme has been launched to develop artistic skills in students aged between 11-15 years. The workshops are being held February half term giving 15 students the opportunity to work with professional artists for a week exploring a diverse range of art techniques, skills and themes.

On completion of the workshops, participants will exhibit their work at the launch night in the Parlour Project Space. As part of their education, students will be involved in curating, installing and promoting the exhibition.

Each participant will receive an art goody bag that includes materials to take home as well as becoming a Young Parlour member for one year. Membership enables the participants to become involved with future art projects and The Parlour as well as access other art spaces in Camden and London.
